

## 2022 Spring Semester English Placement Test

HGU Freshmen need to take English Placement Test to take the English 1 courses which are required for graduation. The results will determine the level of English 1 courses for each student.

The TOEFL ITP(Level 1), which is used as an English Placement Test, consists of the following.

### 1. How to register

**Test Day:** During HanST period (Wednesday, February 23rd , 2022 / 2:30~4:55pm)

**Location:** To be announced (In Campus)

**Fee:** 27,000KRW

**Application period:** Monday, January 17<sup>th</sup> , 2022~ Monday, February 14<sup>th</sup> , 2022 / by 17pm

※Even if you couldn't make a registration within the period, you can apply for it on the day of the test.

### Notes on the day of the test

- 1) Identification with photo (Choose 1 of registration card, driver's license, passport before expiration date)
- 2) Bring a pencil and an eraser (markers, pens can not be used)
